

DEMOCRATIC PARTY MUST FIGHT LIQUOR, SAYS WM. J. BRYAN

Secretary of State Declares the Party Cannot Afford to Take a Stand Against Prohibition.

WARNING IS PRONOUNCED FOR LIQUOR INTERESTS

Bryan Says These Interests Are in Conspiracy Against Everything Good—Hopes to See Democratic Party Favor Prohibition Wherever Question Is Raised.

Washington April 7.—Secretary Bryan tonight made public a letter he had written to W. W. Kennington, democratic national committeeman from Iowa, expressing the hope that Iowa democrats would take a stand for prohibition and vote against candidates who could be controlled by the liquor interests.

In a statement given out with the letter Mr. Bryan said he hoped to see the democratic party take the prohibition side wherever the question was raised and that if the liquor interests insisted on making an issue in the selection of a national committee, the people opposed to the liquor traffic could not afford to ignore the liquor question.

Gets Drop on Negro Who Overpowered Husband—Four Convicts Get Away.

Charlotte, Ga., April 7.—(Special)—After Sheriff John Ward of Crisp county, had been overpowered and his revolver taken from him by a negro prisoner, Tom Holts, and six other negroes had escaped, the sheriff's wife bravely defended her husband through a revolver in the face of Holts and made him drop the officer's weapon before he had an opportunity to use it.

The sheriff and prisoner had fought for probably ten minutes before his wife secured a revolver and went to his rescue.

It was one of the boldest and bravest deeds ever attempted in this section. The sheriff had gone into the jail to save the negroes from being shot.

He unlocked the cell door of Holts and the other negroes and put them in a strength to grab his pistol hand and eventually took the weapon from him. In the meantime, the other negroes bolted from the corridor and escaped.



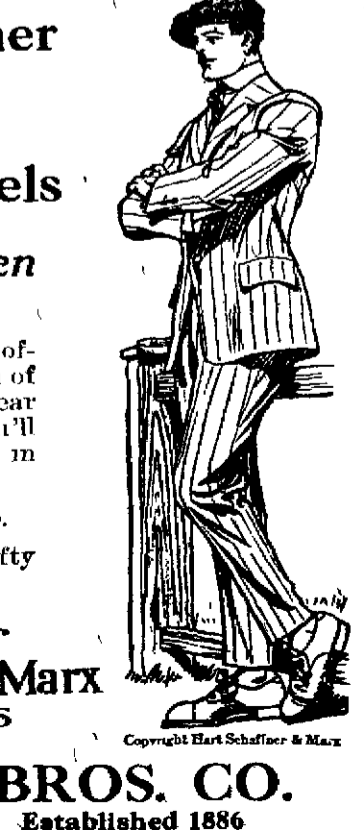

In a statement given out with the letter Mr. Bryan said he hoped to see the democratic party take the prohibition side wherever the question was raised and that if the liquor interests insisted on making an issue in the selection of a national committee, the people opposed to the liquor traffic could not afford to ignore it.

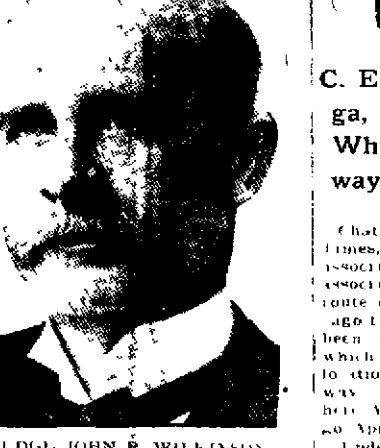
